## **The Little Red Hen Theatre Academy presents “DRAMA CAMP 2020”**

DRAMA CAMP 2020 is an arts educational experience for students in grades K – 8 that will be presented over one week, June 15 – 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the Little Red Hen theatre. The camp focuses on teaching basic drama skills through structured exercises and activities. Participating students are grouped by age/grade with a maximum of 15 participants per group allowed. The curriculum for each age/grade group is designed to be specific to their level and ability in hopes of ensuring an effective and impactful experience for all participants. Due to COVID-19 all DRAMA CAMP activities will be held virtually via a web conferencing application.

The curriculum focus for each group will be as follows:

### **Grades K – 3, Creative Drama through storytelling.**

Activities will focus on teaching the basic drama skills and the use of Body, Voice and Mind. Students will practice these various skills individually and in combination as they work with the teacher to act out these stories.

### **Grades 4—8, Partially Scripted Performance**

Activities for this group will focus on leaning and using a wide variety of drama/acting skills through game playing and improvisatory work, as well as character creation and interaction with fellow actors. Throughout the week, students will work together to perform a short script that requires them to create character, interact believably and employ improvisation at key points to communicate a story.
